Autism is the fastest growing developmental disability in the United States. Recent surveys indicate a 24% increase in prevalence of autism spectrum disorders (ASD) and approximately 1 in 44 children receiving an ASD diagnosis.¹ Carelon Behavioral Health understands that early identification and intervention offer the best opportunity to support a child's healthy development.² Our coordinated model of care makes ASD services readily available to families, when and where they need them. 
